Basic Terms Of The GNU GPL

You can use, study, share and improve this code as long as others now and in the future also have these freedoms.

(the legal text is longer)



It's In The Details

The GNU GPL and CDDL have different terms.



Incompatible But Both Free

GPL code and CDDL code is incompatible.



This Is A General ICT Thing

Microsoft Windows has a big EULA.

Microsoft and Adobe have different terms.

Just try mixing Microsoft and Adobe code.



Common Issues

People don't read the licences.

People mix code with incompatible terms.



Avoiding Issues

Read the licences.

Have work-flows and processes that take Free Software into account.



Business Processes

Free Software != Proprietary Software.

Free Software has its own terms.

Free Software needs its own processes.



In A Nutshell...

Optimise benefit and reduce risk.



Process Examples

List approved Free Software licences.

Refer all other licences to legal.

Have distribution check-lists.



Optimisation Hints

Use compatible licences.

Use popular licences.

Build good communication paths.



Risk Reduction Hints

Use existing best practice.

Pro-actively resolve issues.

Ask for supplier compliance.
