- **Business** (open source governance, enterprise, ecosystem)

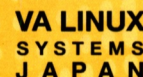
Each of these groups plays a key role in the Linux community and we want to make sure that they are represented at LinuxCon. **The deadline for speaking proposals is May 1st.**
